December 15, 1961 - December 13, 2024

Kenneth Ray Gann (Ken), age 62, went to be with his Lord on December 13, 2024 at his home in Fyffe, AL, after a brave, courageous and faith-filled 4 ½ years battle with cancer.

Ken was married to Pam (Flarity) on March 25, 1995, and together they formed a blended family of three adult children: Heath Blackwell, Paige (Charlie) Myrick, and Ashley (Brad) Bunch. They were also blessed with seven grandchildren: Isabelle (Alonso) Moreno, Owen Blackwell, Brody (Savannah) Blackwell, Baylor, Banks, and Boston Bunch, and Scarlett Myrick and one great grandson, Stetson. Ken graduated from Ider High School in 1980. He had a long and successful career as an insurance agent with ALFA Insurance Company, where he worked for 26 years, planning to retire on January 1, 2026.

Ken's life was full of diverse interests and hobbies. He had a passion for Southern Gospel Music, performing in several quartets and trios, and he sang at many weddings and funerals, often as a soloist in the church choir. Ken's mom described his voice as a God-given talent. His love for music was a constant thread throughout his life.

Ken and Pam found one another on a blind-date in 1994. But in 2005, they moved to a beloved "hobby farm" (a name coined by Ken himself) in Fyffe,

named Paradise Farm, where they spent many happy years working alongside their children and grandchildren. The farm became a source of joy and peace for Ken, as he tended to the cows, mended fences, and cultivated gardens. It provided him with much-needed relaxation from his professional life. One of Ken's greatest dreams was to retire in 2026 and spend even more time on the farm with Pam.

Ken was also known as the voice of the Fyffe Red Devils. From 2015 until his health prevented him from attending, he proudly announced the games, becoming a familiar and cherished presence at the football field. On October 25, 2024, the DeKalb County Board of Education and Fyffe High School honored Ken by naming the press box at Long-Ridgeway Stadium and Paul Benefield Field The "Ken Gann Pressbox."

Above all, Ken loved his family with all of his heart. He was a devoted husband, father, grandfather and great grandfather, often bragging about his grandchildren and attending their many cheer competitions, sporting events, and other activities. His eyes would light up with joy whenever his great-grandson, Stetson, would visit.

Ken leaves behind a legacy of faith, love, and service to others. His memory will live on in the hearts of his family, friends, and all who were blessed to know him.
